What is Pink Shirt Day?

Pink Shirt Day began in Canada in 2007 as a grassroots movement when two students took a stand against bullying by encouraging their peers to wear pink in support of a classmate. It has since grown into an internationally recognized initiative that raises awareness about the impact of bullying and the importance of fostering empathy, respect, and understanding in our schools.

Theme for 2025: "Cultivating a Community of Kindness"

This year's theme, "Cultivating a Community of Kindness," emphasizes the importance of nurturing an environment where kindness grows, and everyone feels supported and valued. As Pilgrims of Hope, our faith calls us to value and respect each person's dignity. We encourage students, staff, and families to think about how their actions can contribute to building a stronger, more inclusive community.

How to Participate

- 1. Wear Pink: Show your support by wearing a pink shirt or any pink accessory on February 26.
- 2. **Engage in Activities**: Be a part of your school events such as assemblies, classroom discussions, and art projects centered around kindness, anti-bullying, and inclusivity.
- 3. Share on Social Media: Join the conversation by sharing your Pink Shirt Day moments on social media using the hashtag **#PinkShirtDay2025**. Let's spread the message far and wide!
- 4. **Support a Cause**: Consider donating to or supporting organizations that work to prevent bullying and promote mental health.
