Welcome to Assumption College

Assumption College School (ACS) opened in 1992 with fewer than 600 students. By 2000, the school had grown to over 1,600 students, resulting in the opening of Holy Trinity in Simcoe. When the schools split, enrollment dropped to under 1,100, but steadily increased to the point that over 1550 students attended the school. The increase in enrollment led to the construction of a new third floor in February 2008. The new facilities have allowed us to offer new and exciting programs to better serve our students.

Assumption College School is committed to providing the best academic experience for all students. As part of that commitment, ACS is now offering Advanced Placement (AP) programming. This program is internationally recognized and administered by the College Board. Focused on providing students with university experiences while still in the high school environment, the Advanced Placement program is an excellent opportunity to prepare to excel at university.

The program provides opportunity for students; starting in Grades 9, 10 and 11 with academic enrichment clubs including STEM, LEAP and Canadian World Studies Advisory Youth Council (CWAYC) and progressing in Grades 12 where students enroll in subject specific Advanced Placement courses (Calculus, Biology, Chemistry, Physics and/or English).
